#### Facts of Accident

- April 25, 2019 Accident
- ▶ I-70 East near Denver, Colorado
- Speed
- 4 deaths, 2 serious injuries
- 28 vehicles
- But...
  - Brake Failure
  - Tried Emergency Brakes
- But, but...
  - Passed at least one runaway truck ramp
  - Reckless driving in hours before the crash
  - Pulled over, but then continued

#### Sentencing

- 40 criminal counts
  - 4 counts of vehicular homicide
  - 6 counts of 1<sup>st</sup> degree assault
  - 24 counts of attempted 1st degree assault
  - 2 counts of vehicular assault
  - 1 county of reckless driving
  - 3 counts of "crime of violence"
- Colorado "Mandatory" Minimum Sentences
- December 2021
  - 110 years in prison for 26 year-old truck driver


#### **Public Outcry**

- Protests
- Driver Boycott
- Change.org petition
- Celebrities
- Politicians
- Outcome
  - 12/31/21 Sentence reduced to 10 years
  - 1/13/22 Scheduled resentencing

## Georgia Legislative Cycle



#### Immediate Legislation

- Apportioning Fault (<u>HB 961/SB 329</u>)
  - "The Hatcher Fix"—<u>Alston & Bird, LLP v. Hatcher</u>
     <u>Mgmt. Holdings, LLC</u>, 312 Ga. 350 (2021)
  - Strikes 4 words; Adds 6 words; and saves millions
  - Senate versus House distinctions
    - House: Applies to <u>cases filed</u> after law takes effect
    - Senate: Applies to <u>causes of action</u> accruing <u>on or after</u> law takes effect

#### **Ongoing Legislation**

- ▶ Tolling SoL Pending Traffic Citation (SB 160)
  - "The Benecke Fix"—<u>Beneke v. Parker</u>, 285 Ga. App. 733 (2009); <u>Williams v. Durden</u>, 347 Ga. App. 363 (2018)
  - Statute would only toll when felony is involved not a complete removal of tolling provision
- ▶ Elimination of Direct Action (SB 191)
  - Introduced in 2021 but voted down in committee
  - Strong GTLA opposition

#### **Enacted Legislation**

- Suspension of Motor Fuel Tax (HB 304)
  - Through May 31, 2022
  - Doesn't affect fed tax
  - Levied on distributors
  - Tax revenue earmarked for roads and bridges ~ \$160M per month



- 2019 Study Committee on Reducing Georgia's Cost of Doing Business
  - Seatbelt Admissibility
  - Phantom Damages
  - Pre-Dismissal Rule
  - Proportionality in Discovery
  - Mandatory Scheduling Orders
  - Trial Bifurcation
  - Increase of Weight Variants for Intrastate Carriers

### Shenanigans

- Placement on the <u>Rules Calendar</u> on the last day speaks volumes.
- Legislation never truly dies on Crossover Day; it's simply reincarnated elsewhere. Also explains why some parties remain neutral until the end.
  - Committee Substitutes
  - Conference Committee
  - Floor Amendments on Sine Die
  - Governor's Veto
- Crossover: March 15
- Sine Die: April 4


